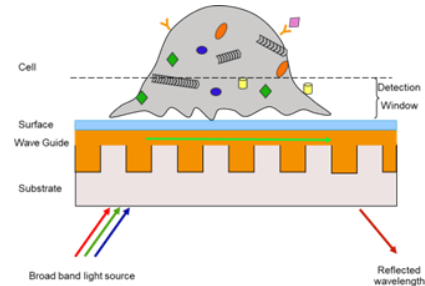

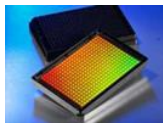
How the technology works

- Cells are cultured on proprietary optical biosensor microplate and then monitored in the PerkinElmer Enspire™ label free reader
- The system detects real time changes in cells as a result of cytoskeletal rearrangement and protein movement close to the cell membrane in response to a stimulus
- The profile is termed “Dynamic Mass Redistribution” DMR
- The response profile is a cellular signature or phenotypic fingerprint of the cell responding to the stimulus

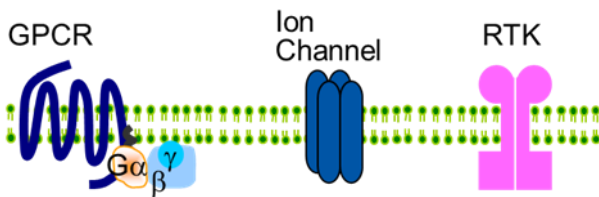


Key Advantages

Cell-based label free assays are: generic, require no genetic manipulation, phenotypic, non-destructive, no interference from auto-fluorescence of cells or compounds. The technology is complimentary to other techniques and can be used for novel biology when the exact mechanism is unknown.

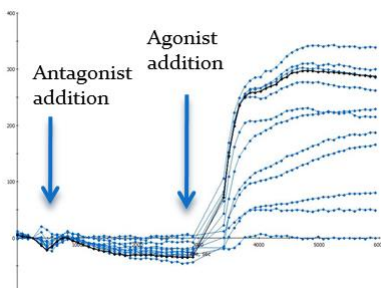

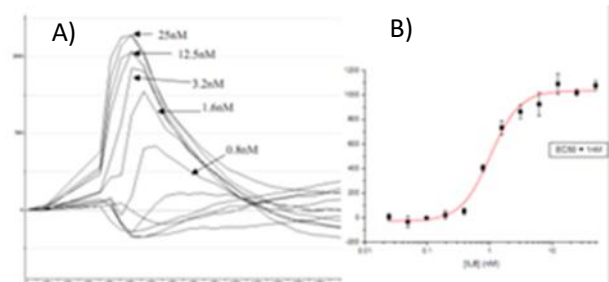
The technology has successfully detected cellular responses for primary, endogenous & over-expressed membrane targets, including: GPCRs, ion channels and RTK

Two addition method for antagonist screening



HEK293 cells expressing the Histamine H1 receptor were first treated with a H1 antagonist followed by addition of a fixed EC₈₀ concentration of an agonist

Real time Neutrophil response to IL8



Neutrophils isolated using density gradient centrifugation, incubated in label free plates (non-adherent) and treated with agonist / antagonists. A) Response profile to IL-8 B) Concentration response graph of the peak response
